## Tracing to FLYING WITCH. Ancestress also of COSMAH (Half sister to Natalma), dam of HALO.

This is the family tracing to the CV Whitney bred mare **Almahmoud** (b.'47); perhaps the strongest sire producing family founded in the last 75 years; throwing 3 major sires (**Northern Dancer**, **Halo** and **Danehill**), two far-above average sires (**Machiavellian** and **Jules**), and three other above-average stallions who sired **Gr.1** winners (**Maribeau** [Bemo], **Cannonade** [Caveat], and **Arctic Tern** [Bering]). **Top Class's** 3rd dam **Coup De Folie** was a ¾ sister to **Bonita Francita**, the dam of **Jules** and **Orpen**; the 4<sup>th</sup> dam **Raise the Standard** was a half-sister to **Northern Dancer** and **Spring Adieu** (by Buckpasser), the 2nd dam of **Danehill**, and his 5<sup>th</sup> dam **Natalma** was a half sister to **Cosmah**, the dam of **Halo**. The closely inbred (3x3 **Almahmoud**) 2nd dam **Coup De Folie** produced 3 **Gr.1** winners and was by Halo from a daughter of Hoist The Flag-Natalma named **Raise The Standard**. A lovely combination as Halo and Hoist The Flag were also crossed in Coup De Folie's ¾ sister **Bonita Francita** (by Halo's son Devil's Bag); the dam of **Gr.1** winning half-brothers **Jules** and **Orpen**.

## **RACING PERFORMANCE**

Coolmore Stud considered Top Class an outstanding racing prospect. After all, their agent Demi O'Byrne paid US \$1.6 million for him at Keeneland sales in 2005. Not only was he the son of the incomparable Storm Cat, but out of the Gone West mare Simadartha, who is a 3/4 sister to French Champion 2-year-old Way Of Light.

Top Class's third dam, champion race mare and producer Coup De Folie, was the granddaughter of Natalma (dam of the incomparable Northern Dancer) who produced no less than five group stakes winners, including leading sire Machiavellian and Champion filly Coup De Genie.

Justifying his credentials, the A.P.O. Brien trained colt won his first outing by an impressive 8 lengths over 7 furlongs on turf. Ridden by champion jockey J A Heffernan in the colors of the infamous Michael Tabor for Coolmore Stud, Top Class brushed aside the other two horses in the betting Raffishing look (by Kingmambo) and Bravely (by Rock of Gibraltar) with ease.

Top Class had the same connections (owner, trainer and jockey) as **Halfway to Heaven** (Thousand Guineas and Multiple **Gr.1** winning filly), **Septimus** (Irish St. Leger, **Gr.1**), **Again** (Moyglare Stud Stakes, **Gr.1**), **Frozen Fire** (Irish Derby, **Gr.1**), **Solider Of Fortune** (Irish Derby, **Gr.1**), **Mount Nelson** (Criterium International, **Gr.1**), **Imagine** (Irish Thousand Guineas, **Gr.1**), **Beckett** (Agha Khan National Stakes, **Gr.1**). This list of horses just goes to show the faith the trio had in "Top Class".

In his second start Top Class was sent to Curragh to try his luck in graded company. The bookies considered him to be the only horse that could challenge the firm favorite **Creachadoir** in the Aussie Rules European Breeders Fund Tetrarch Stakes, **Gr.3**. Top Class ran a decent race, but the race going did not suit him one bit. **Creachadoir** won the race and Top Class ran a mere 5 lengths behind him but only 2 lengths behind the horse that came in 2<sup>nd</sup>, **Mr Napper Tandy**. **Creachadoir** went on to win the Judmonte Lockinge Stakes, **Gr.1**, multiple **Gr.3** races and he placed 2nd in the Hong Kong Mile, **Gr.1** (to **Good Ba Ba** by a short head), Irish Two Thousand Guineas, **Gr.1**, Poule D'Essai des Poulains, **Gr.1**, etc. **Mr. Napper Tandy** went on to win the San Francisco Mile, **Gr.2**, placed in multiple black type races and ran within 2 lengths of the winner **Gio Ponti** in the Frank E Kilroe Mile, **Gr.1**.

**Eyshal**, the horse that ran 3rd in the same race was yet another excellent racehorse. Top Class ran a mere three quarter of a length behind him in the same race. Eyshal went on to win the Jebsen Centenary Vase, **Gr.3**, ran 3rd in Laing O'Rourke National Stakes, **Gr.1** (behind **Teofilo** and **Holy Roman Emperor**) and in The Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup, **Gr.1**.

**Alexander Tango**, the Champion **Gr.1** winning and Irish Thousand guineas placed filly (unfortunately died as 3-year-old) was also a part of this field of runners. Top Class ran only half-length behind this wonder filly and a neck behind the multiple **Gr.3** winning, **Confuchias**.

In his third start Top Class finished 1 3/4 lengths away behind the winner **Hard Rock City** over 7 furlongs. Hard Rock City won 8 races and placed second in The Emirates Airline Minstrel Stakes, **Gr.3** and multiple other black type races. The horse that placed second in the same race, **Duff**, went on to win the DFS Park Stakes, **Gr.2**, Coolmore Stud Champions Concorde Stakes, **Gr.3**, Ballycorus Stakes, **Gr.3** and other listed races. Duff also ran placed in numerous **Gr.2** and **Gr.3** events as well as placing 4<sup>th</sup> in The Laing O'Rourke National Stakes, **Gr.1** (behind **George Washington**, **Golden Arrow** and **Heatseeker**. Top Class finished only a mere length behind Duff over the distance. However, Top Class beat the favourite **Lord Admiral** in the race. Lord Admiral was a champion racehorse that won the Jebel Hatta- Nayef, **Gr.2**, Al Rashidiya Stakes, **Gr.3**, Ballycorus Stakes, **Gr.3**, Knockaire Stakes, **L**, Glencairn Stakes, **L** and placed multiple times in graded races including a 3rd in Tattersalls Gold Cup, **Gr.1** and also a fourth place finish in The Shadwell Turf Mile Stakes, **Gr.1**.

The company **Top Class** raced is testament to the fact that he was not just some ordinary racehorse. Unfortunately, Top Class's racing career was to be cut short to just 5 starts as a 3-year-old as he sustained a racing injury. His owners tried their level best to get him right, but it was not to be.

Physically, Top Class is an eye-catcher, as any \$1.6 million yearling is sure to be. Standing at 16 hands, this coal-black stallion looks and moves just like his sire. As you can see from the photo, he stands over a lot of ground, just like like Storm Cat, and carries that same athletic physique as well. It is a well-accepted fact in the U.S. that Storm Cat's best sons at stud are those horses that most closely resemble him in conformation. It would be difficult to find two horses more physically alike than Top Class and Storm Cat.
